Navy Pier IMAX at AMC will reopen featuring IMAX's laser projection; additional renovations coming in 2017

Leawood, Kan. (Nov. 15, 2016) – AMC Theatres® (NYSE: AMC), IMAX Corporation (NYSE:IMAX) and Navy Pier today announced that Navy Pier IMAX at AMC in Chicago reopens for business today, Nov. 15. Today's opening ensures guests in Chicago can enjoy the 6 p.m. debut of *FANTASTIC BEASTS AND WHERE TO FIND THEM* on Thursday, Nov. 17. The theatre will remain open throughout the holiday season, and will undergo additional renovations in early 2017.

Upon its initial reopening, Navy Pier IMAX at AMC will feature IMAX's state-of-the-art laser projection system. In early 2017, the theatre will close for additional renovations, including installing IMAX's immersive 12-channel sound, a completely renovated concession area and all new plush rocker seating. The theatre is expected to reopen with all renovations complete by late spring of 2017.

IMAX with laser represents a quantum leap forward in cinema technology — providing audiences with sharper, brighter, clearer and more vivid digital images than ever. Designed from the ground up for IMAX's largest screens, the dual 4K laser projection system is equipped with a new optical engine and suite of proprietary IMAX technologies capable of projecting an image with up to a 1.43:1 aspect ratio with maximum resolution and sharpness, unparalleled 2D and 3D brightness, industry-leading contrast and an expanded color gamut that will allow filmmakers to present more vivid and exotic colors than ever before.

"Our longtime partners at AMC share our commitment to providing moviegoers a truly unique and cutting-edge experience and we're excited to take that even further with the launch of our new laser system at Navy Pier," said Mark Welton, President, IMAX Theatres. "Navy Pier IMAX at AMC theatre patrons are going to experience dramatic

increases in brightness, contrast and color, which ultimately results in suspending disbelief when experiencing today's biggest movies in IMAX."

IMAX's next-generation sound technology, which is expected to be installed in early 2017, will deliver even greater power and precision for ultimate audio immersion. It will be upgraded to 12 discrete channels plus sub-bass, and include additional side channels as well as new overhead channels that will improve the system's ability to position sounds around the audience and further ensure every seat is the best in the house.

AMC Theatres previously installed IMAX with laser at its IMAX at AMC Metreon 16 location in San Francisco and IMAX at AMC Universal CityWalk 19 in Los Angeles.
