Kimberly brings more than 25 years of senior leadership experience within the performing arts and higher education and has most recently served as Managing Director of the Tony Award-winning Children's Theatre Company, the nation's largest and most acclaimed theater dedicated to serving multigenerational audiences.

These creative and entrepreneurial new leaders are ambitious for Chicago Shakespeare. Their bold, forward-thinking vision will continue to raise the Theater's global profile, building upon the foundation laid by our founding Artistic Director Barbara Gaines, Executive Director Criss Henderson, our board of directors, supporters, and theater professionals.

We cannot reach what we may become without you—our audience, so I hope we will have the honor of welcoming you to the Theater again and again.

Legacy. It's the promise between an illustrious past and a purposeful future. Bill Brodsky's legacy is legendary. Bill moved from Wall Street to LaSalle Street four decades ago and helped make Chicago synonymous with "futures and options."

As the former President and CEO of the Chicago Mercantile Exchange and the Chairman and CEO of the Chicago Board Options Exchange, he oversaw the development of financial tools that forever changed the way the world does business. The CME's Globex became the first around-theclock automated global trading system, and the Cboe's Volatility Index or VIX became known as the "fear gauge" or barometer of the stock market. Brodsky was elected the first exchange executive from Chicago to serve as chairman of the World Federation of Exchanges; and he helped Governor Pritzker consolidate a frayed patchwork of 652 pension funds into two multibillion funds for the state's first responders, maximizing returns and minimizing costs for Illinois taxpayers.

As Chairman of Navy Pier from 2013 to 2023, he secured this treasured landmark's future as an independent nonprofit. Over a decade of bullish support and bearish resolve, he helped attract crucial funding, including a transformational \$20 million legacy gift to create Polk Bros Park. Along with this visionary new gateway to the Pier, he oversaw the fruition of the Pier's Centennial Vision, a \$400 million transformation that ushered in the redevelopment of the Pier's South Dock, the modernized Fifth Third Bank Family Pavilion, the construction of the People's Energy Welcome Pavilion, and the opening of the boutique Sable Hotel—all with a focus on economic and environmental sustainability and best in class non-profit corporate governance. When the pandemic forced Navy Pier into a financial crisis, he led the cause to "save the pier" by bolstering philanthropic fundraising efforts to ensure the Pier's survival.

Recipient of many awards, including the State of Illinois' highest civilian recognition, the Order of Lincoln, Bill was recently honored by the Chicago History Museum's "Making History Award" for Corporate Leadership and Innovation. Bill generously shares his innovative thinking with other nonprofits such as Northwestern Medicine, which he also chaired, and his alma mater, Syracuse University. He married his college sweetheart, Joan, and they raised three now married sons and six grandchildren. Both Bill and Joan received presidential appointments last summer from another Syracuse classmate, Joe Biden. Through it all, they still make time for their favorite activity: visiting the Pier with family and friends and most importantly—people watching at the People's Pier.

TONIGHT WE HONOR Chicago Shakespeare Theater

Chicago Shakespeare Theater is, at its core, about people: connecting audiences and artists, partnering with teachers and students, and sharing unforgettable theatrical experiences with friends and neighbors.

A Regional Tony Award recipient, Chicago Shakespeare produces a bold and innovative year-round season—plays, musicals, world premieres, family productions, and theatrical presentations from around the globe—alongside education programming for students, teachers, and lifelong learners, and engagement with communities across the city.

Founded in 1986, the Theater has evolved to present as many as twenty productions and 650 performances annually and has been honored with numerous awards. Chicago Shakespeare is the city's leading presenter of international work and has toured its own productions to five continents.

A national leader in the field, the Theater's arts-in-literacy programs support the work in classrooms across the region for tens of thousands of students each year by bringing complex texts to life onstage and through professional learning opportunities for teachers. Now in its twelfth year, Chicago Shakespeare in the Parks remains a key component of the Theater's CoLab initiatives, a year-round program rooted in engagement with neighborhoods and collaborations with local artists.

Located on Chicago's iconic Navy Pier, Chicago Shakespeare's campus features three theater venues: the Jentes Family Courtyard Theater, a 500-seat performance space that evokes Shakespeare's Globe and the Royal Shakespeare Company's Swan Theatre; The Yard at Chicago Shakespeare, one of the most dynamic and flexible theater venues in the world, with audience capacities ranging from 150 to 850; and the Thoma Theater Upstairs, a 200-seat venue in which both the stage and seating configuration can be arranged in a variety of ways.

Onstage, in classrooms and neighborhoods across the city, and in venues around the world, Chicago Shakespeare is a multifaceted cultural hub inviting audiences, artists, and community members to share powerful stories that connect and inspire.

David Chiriboga is a Chicago-based musician of Ecuadorian heritage, specializing in Spanish Guitar (Flamenco, Latin, Spanish Classical). Much of David's foundation was formed through his studies in southern Spain.

Olya Prohorova, originally from Moldova, is a highly versatile violinist enjoying a career in multiple music genres - from classical, to rock, country and Eastern European folk music.

As as duo, they fuse their unique styles and perform arrangements of popular Spanish Guitar repertoire. They have collectively performed internationally in countries such as Italy, Mexico, Germany, Ukraine, Bulgaria, Japan, among more.




Derrick Tate, Saxophone




